### Upcoming Exhibition

Our inaugural exhibition will be a group show which will run from 27 March to 3 May 2026. The exhibition will celebrate local artists, presenting a fantastic opportunity for artists of all stages, from early career to established, to exhibit work in our newly created gallery space, **Art Gallery | Beachport** located within the Beachport Visitor Information Centre.

### Our Vision

Art Gallery | Beachport will present contemporary arts and cultural work across multi-art practices. We will work collaboratively with artists and other arts and cultural organisations to share our uniqueness with audiences. We aim to stimulate engagement and cultural exchange through the wonderful and unexpected curiosities of our people and our place, with Beachport at the heart of our vision.

### About

We are inviting artists to submit an Expression of Interest for the first show, a group exhibition that will be held at Art Gallery | Beachport, Friday 27 March – Sunday 3 May 2026.

We invite artists from Beachport & Muggleton to submit works for consideration. The exhibition will bring together a diverse collection of paintings, drawings, printmaking, mixed media, ceramics, textiles, fine art photography and sculptural works that will reflect the breadth of local artistic talent.

### Submissions

Submissions must be made using the form below and returned to the Beachport Visitor Information Centre or emailed before midnight Sunday 1 March 2026 to [cmerilynsea@yahoo.com](mailto:cmerilynsea@yahoo.com)

- There is no cost to be involved in this exhibition however the process is selective due to limited space.
- Making a submission does not guarantee entry into the exhibition. We are using our inaugural exhibition group show to discover and support new and existing local talent. An open call like this one will provide us with the knowledge to develop and program future exhibitions – so if you're keen to see your work on the walls of the Art Gallery - Beachport, this is a wonderful opportunity to create an awareness of your work.

### Image of your artwork

- Please provide 1 image per artwork with a maximum of 3 artworks / images submitted.

### Uploaded images should be:

- High resolution and saved in .jpg or .png format
- Preferred file size is no more than 2MB
- The file name must include the artist's name, title of work, dimensions and medium

# Terms & Conditions

## Submission Form

Please complete the submission form:

- Complete all the required fields, ensuring all details are correct.
- Artwork dimensions **MUST** be entered in mm (not cm or inches).  
Should your work be selected, your name and the artwork details you include in this submission form will be used to generate the exhibition information - **PLEASE ENSURE THEY ARE CORRECT** and keep a record of your artwork details.
- Please make one submission only. Up to three artworks may be included in your one submission.
- There is no cost to be involved in this exhibition.

## Selection and notification

Please understand Gallery space is limited. Artwork will be selected for exhibition at the curators' discretion.

By submitting your application, you accept that making a submission does not guarantee you entry into the exhibition.

Artists will be notified if their work has been selected for exhibition by personal email on 6 March 2026.

The selected artists will also be published on our website. Please note: Our website is currently in development.

## Artwork requirements

- Artwork must be the artist's own work.
- Accepted media include Painting, Drawing, Printmaking, Fine Art Photography, Sculpture, Ceramics and Textiles
- Artwork delivered to Art Gallery-Beachport must be **CLEARLY MARKED** on the reverse with the artist's name, and title of the work.
- Please ensure all 2D works are ready to hang, with D-rings and hanging wire attached.
- 3D works must be stable, free-standing, or supplied with a safe display base/pedestal/plinth
- Artists are responsible for bearing all costs related to the creation, delivery and collection of their artwork for this exhibition. There are no costs payable to Art Gallery - Beachport to participate in the show.

## Delivery of Artwork

**Your artwork must be delivered to the Gallery located in the Visitor Information Centre between:**

**10am – 4pm Friday 20 March 2026 or 10am – 2pm Saturday 21 March 2026**

All artwork must be delivered to the Art Gallery Beachport by 2pm Saturday 21 March 2026. Work delivered after this date may not be accepted into the show

## Insurance & Indemnity

Art Gallery - Beachport will exercise all due care with the works submitted but will not be responsible for any loss or damage suffered whatsoever to any artwork while in transit or under its control. Each artist shall indemnify Art Gallery - Beachport against any loss or damage suffered to their artwork whatsoever. Each artist is responsible for their own insurance cover. By submitting this application, you agree to these conditions.

## Sales & Commission

- Artwork is required to be for sale.
- Artwork sold at Art Gallery – Beachport will attract a 30% commission on sales.
- Sales will be processed up to 31 days after the close of the exhibition.

## Photography & Reproduction of Artwork

All applicants authorise Art Gallery-Beachport formally and irrevocably, to capture and publish images of their works free of copyright, totally or partly, in all publications (catalogues, folders, posters, slide shows, brochures etc) related to promotion and documentation of this exhibition, as well as on the Art Gallery-Beachport website and social media.

## Collection of unsold works

Works not sold during the exhibition period must be collected from Art Gallery-Beachport after the conclusion of the exhibition during the following times:

**3 – 4pm Sunday 3 May or 10am – 2 pm Monday 4 May 2026**

Any artwork not collected after the exhibition are liable to be stored at the artist's expense and disposed of if not collected within a reasonable timeframe.
