Beachport Conservation Park

Lake George has magnificent bird life and offers excellent windsurfing. Serene camping and picnic areas, situated on the shores of Lake George. Permits available online and at the Visitor Information Centre. This park protects the dunes and coastal vegetation between Lake George and the Southern Ocean. The two tracks to the coast through the park are only suitable for 4WD vehicles or walking. Conventional vehicles can get to the coast as far as Woolley Rocks along the Bowman Scenic Drive.

Millicent Road
The artwork celebrates what is special about Beachport – The natural environment - The fishing industry – The people who live here.



Woakwine Cutting

12km north of Beachport on the Southern Ports Highway
As Australia's biggest one-man engineering feat, Woakwine Cutting was created to drain swampland for pastoral use. A viewing platform and picnic area has been established at the head of the cutting. The project is documented for all visitors to read.



Durant's Lookout

South West Terrace
Durant's Lookout provides spectacular views of the township of Beachport, Rivoli Bay, Beachport Conservation Park and the Southern Ocean. The Rivoli Bay and Beachport Lions Club members built the raised platform on the site and it was named for the late Mr Doug Durant, a long time resident of Beachport (car access only).



Customs House

Corner Railway Tce & Millicent Rd
The customs house, restored to a working office as it was in the late 19th century. Enter through the original railway turnstile in the fence from Railway Terrace to view the display.



Beachport & District Branch of National Trust SA Old Wool & Grain Store Museum

Railway Terrace
Tells the story of the district's past, including an insight into Beachport's whaling and fishing history. Open 10am – 4pm daily. Other times can be arranged by appointment. Phone 08 8735 8013. Check the roster in the window.

Beach Road
The second longest jetty in South Australia at 772m long.

Pool of Siloam (Salt Lake)

Bowman Scenic Drive
A salt lake almost seven times saltier than the sea which is reputed to relieve sufferers of arthritis and rheumatism. The high salt concentration in the water makes swimming very easy, as the water is extremely buoyant. A safe and sheltered swimming area with picnic area, change rooms and summer shower.



Bowman Scenic Drive

Scenic drive following the spectacular rugged coast of the Southern Ocean. Great for a leisurely walk along the beach, scuba diving, surf fishing or looking at the sea from one of the many lookouts. Please Note: there are dangerous undertows in the waters along these beaches. Take care.
